Families will be given the ability to opt-in for a one semester commitment to this alternative model for delivering instruction to students. This will be available for all families not ready for their child(children) to return to in-person or hybrid learning.

Where does learning occur?

At home

When do students attend?

Students will “attend” during the regular school day

What does instruction look like?

- Learning will occur through a blend of synchronous and asynchronous engagement activities taught by a SDMF teacher
- District-designed curriculum or courseware may be used. This is dependent on enrollment in the fully-virtual option
- English language arts, math, science, social studies, and specials.
- Feedback to students to guide their learning will be prioritized

What should families expect?

- Registration commitment for one semester
- Provide daily support at home for approximately 4-6 hours of learning support each day
- Support daily student attendance
- Provide constructive learning environment
- Work together with their child’s teacher to monitor their progress
