FULLY VIRTUAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Families will be given the ability to opt-in for a one semester commitment to this alternative model for delivering instruction to students. This will be available for all families not ready for their child(children) to return to inperson or hybrid learning.

Where does learning occur?

At home

When do students attend?

Students will "attend" during the regular school day

What does instruction look like?

- Learning will occur through a blend of synchronous and asynchronous engagement activities taught by a SDMF teacher
- District-designed curriculum or courseware may be used. This is dependent on enrollment in the fully-virtual option
- English language arts, math, science, social studies, and specials.
- Feedback to students to guide their learning will be prioritized

What should families expect?

- Registration commitment for one semester
- Provide daily support at home for approximately 4-6 hours of learning support each day
- Support daily student attendance
- Provide constructive learning environment
- Work together with their child's teacher to monitor their progress
