## Where does learning occur?

At home

#### When do students attend?

Students will "attend" during the regular school day

#### What does instruction look like?

- Learning will occur through a blend of synchronous and asynchronous engagement activities taught by a SDMF teacher
- District-designed curriculum or courseware may be used. This is dependent on enrollment in the fully-virtual option
- English language arts, math, science, and social studies. Electives may be more limited. Students may attend in-person/hybrid for electives by request
- Feedback to students to guide their learning will be prioritized

# What should families expect?

- Registration commitment for 1 semester
- Provide daily support at home for learning each school day
- Support daily student attendance
- Provide constructive learning environment
- Work together with their child's teachers to monitor their progress

# What activities or athletic options are available to students?

- Students can participate in activities and athletics
- Daily attendance expectations are the same as in-person
