WHAT DO I DO?

PLEASE DO NOT COMMUNICATE WITH YOUR TEAM MEMBERS. WE UNDERSTAND YOUR INTENT IS TO CARE AND BE TRANSPARENT WITH YOUR COLLEAGUES, HOWEVER THE IMPACT IS NOT POSITIVE. PLEASE TRUST THE PROCESS AND ALLOW THE CONTACT TRACING TO BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO ANY COMMUNCIATION WITH YOUR TEAM MEMBERS.

Please exit your building or do not report to work. Contact your direct supervisor and Human Resources

CONTACT TRACING WILL BE INITIATED BY THE APPROPRIATE DISTRICT TEAM MEMBERS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

Human Resources will assess applicable benefits and continue contact with employee. The Health Department will contact employee to provide a return to work date

Stay home at least 10 days from the date of the test and monitor for symptoms. Your direct supervisor will review the feasibility of remote work based on the role and needs of the District.
