All applications must include the SIX (6) questions below answered and attached, plus any other question(s) for each specific application. Follow directions carefully.

Type <u>detailed</u> responses <u>accurately and honestly</u> to the following questions on a separate sheet & staple to your application.

- 1. <u>LIST</u> the college/university or career/technical school where you plan to further your education and your major or career choice. <u>Describe</u> your most meaningful experience (s) at Menomonee Falls High School and how they relate to your future goals or career.
- 2. <u>LIST</u> all your <u>in-school</u> athletics, activities, clubs and organizations; amount of time spent in each, and what your involvement was in each. Include any honors, awards, or recognition you have received from the above activities. (**Be detailed with time and dates of involvement**)
- 3. <u>LIST</u> all your <u>out-of-school</u> activities (including employment, community, church, service and volunteer organizations); years involved, and your role in each. Include any honors, awards, or recognition you have received from the above activities. <u>(Be detailed with time and dates of involvement)</u>
- 4. **DESCRIBE** your most fulfilling community service/volunteer activity and provide examples on how you will continue to do community service in the future.
- 5. **PROVIDE** a description of the qualities you believe a leader should embody. How do you display those qualities in your school activities, community, and work or in your everyday life?
- 6. **CONSIDER** something in your life you think goes unnoticed and write about why it's important to you. Choose a topic different from the above questions.

Answer the below questions pertaining to <u>EACH</u> specific scholarship you are applying.

List instruments you play and how long you've played them.

List all Menomonee Falls school band or orchestra events in which you played.

List all bands or orchestra organizations you've played in outside of Menomonee Falls schools, years involved, and instruments played.

List all volunteer activities that you have participated in that are directly related to Band/Orchestra program. What musician(s) have influenced you and why?

What leadership roles have you taken on within the band/orchestra program?

Share your favorite memory from your middle or high school band or orchestra experience.

If applying for the Ben Franklin PIE Alumni Scholarship: (Needed to be at BF for at least three (3) years)

Why did you apply for this scholarship? Why do you feel you should receive this scholarship over any other applicant? What advice would you give to students at Ben Franklin to help them to begin to prepare for college or career/technical school? Please share a memory of a person, event or activity that occurred while you were at Ben Franklin and explain how you were influenced by it.

If applying for the Dr. Catherine (Riesch) Coyle Respect Life Scholarship:

In a well-written, well-developed essay, please explain how your activities and involvement exemplify the components of this motto and enhance the well-being of our community. Why do you deserve an award from our service-oriented organization? Your response to this topic will carry considerable weight in our selection of recipients. Applicants must be in the top 30% of the class.

List the business classes you took 9-12. Rank in order of important which classes were the most beneficial and why.

If applying for the Gail Sykora Scholarship:

Please describe what your plans are and how this scholarship will help you fulfill those plans.

If applying for the Greco Family Scholarship:

Please explain or demonstrate your financial need or any financial barriers you may have in funding your college education.

If applying for the James and Lynn E. Zindl, Business Scholarship:

Describe your favorite business class and why? What business class that you took at MFHS will help you the most in the future? Explain why all students in high school should take business classes?

If applying for Kaden Diehl Valley View Elementary Alumni Scholarship:

Kaden was known for his compassion and kindness to others. Please give an example of when you reflected the spirit of compassion and kindness to others in your life and the result of your effort.
